

Floyd County Board of Commissioners Ordinance FCO 2010 - 24

Whereas, the Floyd County Board of Commissioners met on December 21, 2010 on this matter pursuant to the amending of Floyd County Ordinance 2006-XV (an ordinance amending the Floyd County Ordinance 2002-XVI and Floyd County Personnel Policy Handbook regarding County Employee Wage and Salaries during Weather Emergencies and Weather Watches)

Whereas, the County is desirous to provide certain level of continuation of operations during potential weather emergencies,

Now Therefore,


Be it Ordained, that the Floyd County Board of Commissioners amend and add section 17 to the Floyd County Ordinance 2006-XVI as follows:

- 17) The County deems that the following dates are to be described as premium pay holidays for the Floyd County Road Department. These calendar days are December 24 and December 25. Any employee who physically works on either of these dates will receive the pay rate of time and half for any work on these two dates.


All employees will receive the prescribed holiday pay for such days as defined by the County Policy Manual. The County policy regarding forty (40) physical hours worked for the purpose of calculation of overtime does not apply to the two dates. This policy is only applicable to the aforementioned dates listed in the above paragraph.

SO RESOLVED this 21st day of Dec., 2010.


