FCO 2013 - V (A)

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PROCEDURES FOR REQUESING FUNDS FROM 911

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, desires to reduce the possible confusion or disagreements surrounding the use of said funds; and

WHEREAS, the statute governing the permitted uses and disbursements of the 911 funds has recently been revised;

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, any and all requests for funds from Floyd County's 911 funds shall be submitted in writing and shall reference the applicable provisions of the governing statute, I.C. 36-8-16.7-38. No request shall be considered by the County Board of Commissioners or the County Council unless and until the aforesaid appropriate statutory authorization is cited by the requesting person or agency.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, if the Board of Commissioners and/or the County Council rely upon any statutory provisions to make their determinations or decisions, they shall advise the requesting person or agency of any such statutory provision.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this ordinance is enacted solely to provide a measure of clarity in the eligibility and/or use of the 911 funds. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed as requiring the Board of Commissioners or the County Council to approve any requests or to otherwise reduce the current discretion and authority of the Board of Commissioners or the County Council.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage.
