FLOYD COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER ORDINANCE

Ordinance to Establish Non-Reverting Special Vehicle & Equipment Fund

Whereas a Special Vehicle & Equipment fund has been established by Floyd County government.

Whereas the Special Vehicle & Equipment Fund was identified historically as line item 0716 and is currently identified as line item 4910.

Whereas Ordinances have been passed over the years putting money in this account.

1. Ordinance No. FCO 84-1 authorizing money collected from inspections be deposited into a fund for equipment and training.
2. Ordinance No. FCO-6 authorizing fees collected from background checks be put in the police equipment account and used for police equipment or education.
3. Floyd County Ordinance 2003 – XXX establishing fees for copies of investigative photographs to be deposited in the Floyd County Sheriff's equipment fund.
4. Floyd County Ordinance 2004 –XVII establishing fees for fingerprinting services to be deposited in the Floyd County Sheriff's Equipment Fund.
5. FCO 2007 – XVII establishing a tow fee to be deposited in the Sheriff's Fund.
6. Ordinance No. FCO – 2008 – VI establishing a tow-in fee to be paid into the Sheriff's Special Car Fund.
7. Floyd County Resolution 2008 – XI directing money received from the Crawford County Board of Commissioners from the sale of a vehicle be deposited to account 0716, the Special Vehicle & Equipment Fund.

Whereas Floyd County Government has treated this account as a non-reverting account over the years.

Whereas it was determined that an ordinance establishing this account as a non-reverting has not been passed.

Whereas the Commissioners have the authority under IC 36-1-3-6 (the Home Rule statute) to adopt an ordinance establishing a non-reverting account for the Special Vehicle & Equipment Fund.


BE IT ORDAINED that the Floyd County Commissioners establish the Special Vehicle & Equipment Fund (4910) as a non-reverting fund. In addition, the Floyd County Commissioners deem all funds currently in the Special Vehicle & Equipment Fund to be non-reverting.

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 2003- XXX

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PHOTO FEE
TO BE COLLECTED BY THE FLOYD COUNTY SHERIFF

WHEREAS, by the provisions of IC 36-1-3, et seq., the power of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd (Board) to establish a service charge or user fee not greater than that reasonably related to the actual costs and expenses incurred in providing services is confirmed; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been informed and advised that the Floyd County Sheriff and the personnel of his Department expend considerable time, effort, and resources in providing copies of investigative photographs to other law enforcement agencies, governmental entities, and the public; and

WHEREAS, the nature of the services rendered by the Floyd County Sheriff and his personnel in processing requests for photographs is deemed by the Board to be of such a nature as to warrant the imposition of a Photo Fee for same; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it appropriate that funds generated by and through the collection of Photo Fees be deposited in the Floyd County Sheriff's Equipment Fund to defray the cost of materials, supplies, and postage in providing investigative photographs to interested persons and for such other purposes for which said fund was created.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, that there is hereby created and imposed a Photo Fee of five dollars (\$5.00), to be collected by the Floyd County Sheriff for each copy of an investigative photograph taken by a member of the Floyd County Sheriff's Department and provided to a person, firm, corporation, or entity requesting same.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all fees collected by the Floyd County Sheriff pursuant to this ordinance shall be deposited in the Floyd County Sheriff's Equipment Fund, which fund and revenue shall be used to defray expenses incurred or to be incurred by the Floyd County Sheriff in providing copies of photographs to the public, and for such other purposes for which said fund was created.

TO BE COLLECTED BY THE FLOYD COUNTY SHERIFF

WHEREAS, by the provisions of IC 36-1-3, et seq., the power of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd (Board) to establish a service charge or user fee not greater than that reasonably related to the actual costs and expenses incurred in providing services is confirmed; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been informed and advised that the Floyd County Sheriff and the personnel of his Department expend considerable time, effort, and resources in providing finger printing services to the public; and

WHEREAS, the nature of the services rendered by the Floyd County Sheriff and his personnel in processing requests for such services is deemed by the Board to be of such a nature as to warrant the imposition of a fee for same; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it appropriate that funds generated by and through the collection of Photo Fees be deposited in the Floyd County Sheriff's Equipment Fund to defray the cost of materials and supplies in providing fingerprinting services and for such other purposes for which said fund was created.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, that there is hereby created and imposed a Fingerprinting Fee of five dollars (\$5.00), to be collected by the Floyd County Sheriff from each member of the general public requesting to be fingerprinted.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all fees collected by the Floyd County Sheriff pursuant to this ordinance shall be deposited in the Floyd County Sheriff's Equipment Fund, which fund and revenue shall be used to defray expenses incurred or to be incurred by the Floyd County Sheriff in providing fingerprinting services to the public, and for such other purposes for which said fund was created.

ORDINANCE NO. FCO 2007-XVII
AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE SHERIFF'S TOWING FEE

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Police Department (the "Department") must frequently order vehicles towed from Floyd County public ways as well as from private property; and

WHEREAS, each time the Department must order a vehicle towed, the Department incurs substantial processing costs, to include but not limited to: a complete inventory of the contents of the vehicle, police officer wait time on wrecker arrival, paperwork processing with wrecker operator and detailing police impound procedures, etc.; and

WHEREAS, a fee of thirty-five (\$35.00) Dollars for each vehicle towed would reasonably compensate the Department for its processing costs. This would apply to criminal and traffic infraction violation tow-ins; and

WHEREAS, this proposed ordinance has been duly advertised and a public hearing has been held concerning the establishment of this tow-in fee.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have the authority under I.C. 36-1-3-6 (the "Home Rule") to adopt an ordinance under Home Rule to establish and authorize the tow-in fee.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained:

Section 1. Vehicle Tow-in Fee

- (A) The Floyd County Police Department may assess a thirty-five (\$35.00 Dollar tow-in fee for each vehicle the Department orders towed.
- (B) Any entity that provides tow-in services for the Department shall collect the Department's tow-in fee along with its fees prior to releasing any towed vehicle to its owners and shall forward the Department's tow-in fees to the County Auditor's Office at least quarterly. The Auditor is hereby directed to deposit any such revenues received into the Sheriff's Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that all Ordinances of Floyd County, Indiana which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.



ORDINANCE NO. FCO-2008-VI
AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE SHERIFF'S TOWING FEE

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Police Department (the "Department") must frequently order vehicles towed from Floyd County public ways as well as from private property; and

WHEREAS, each time the Department must order a vehicle towed, the Department incurs substantial processing costs, to include but not limited to: a complete inventory of the contents of the vehicle, police officer wait time on wrecker arrival, paperwork processing with wrecker operator and detailing police impound procedures, and other services; and

WHEREAS, a fee of THIRTY-FIVE (\$35.00) DOLLARS for each vehicle towed would reasonably compensate the Department for its processing costs. This would apply to criminal and traffic infraction violation tow-ins; and

WHEREAS, this proposed ordinance has been duly advertised and a public hearing has been held concerning the establishment of this tow-in fee;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have the authority under IC 36-1-3-6 (the "Home Rule") to adopt an ordinance under Home Rule to establish and authorize the tow-in fee.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained:

Section 1. Vehicle Tow-In Fee

(A)The Floyd County Police Department may assess a THIRTY-FIVE (\$35.00) DOLLAR tow-in fee for each vehicle the Department orders towed.

(B)The Sheriff's Department shall collect the tow-in fee prior to releasing any towed vehicle to its owners and shall forward the Department's tow-in fees to the county Auditor's Office at least quarterly. The Auditor is hereby directed to deposit any such revenues received into the Sheriff's Special Car Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that all Ordinances of Floyd County, Indiana which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


Upon the payment of \$3,600.00 to the Floyd County Auditor for said vehicle.

ORDINANCE NO. FCO 84-1

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES FOR OUT-OF-STATE
VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER INSPECTIONS

WHEREAS, Public law 120, Section 1, enacted by the 1983 Legislature and effective September 1, 1983, now permits peace officers of the state to charge a fee for inspecting vehicles which must be inspected prior to registration in the State of Indiana; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners deems it desirable to impose a fee for inspecting applicable motor vehicles, which fee is not a greater charge for the service than that reasonably related to the cost of the service provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA, That from and hereafter the date of passage and adoption of this Ordinance, the Police Department of Floyd County is authorized and directed to collect a fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) for the inspection process for each motor vehicle which must be inspected prior to registration in the State of Indiana.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED That a receipt shall be issued by the Police Department for each such inspection fee collected; that the revenues so collected shall be periodically, and not less than monthly, delivered to the Auditor of Floyd County

and such revenues received from the inspections authorized by this Ordinance shall be deposited into a fund for the purpose of equipment and training for the Floyd County Police Department.

BY THE FLOYD COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, THE FLOYD COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT RECEIVES NUMEROUS REQUESTS FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC REGARDING EMPLOYEE BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR PERSONS BEING CONSIDERED FOR HIRE BY PRIVATE AND GOVERNMENTAL FIRMS:


WHEREAS, THIS SERVICE REQUIRES NUMEROUS MAN-HOURS OF ON-DUTY OFFICERS AT THE FLOYD COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT AND SHOULD PROPERLY BE DEFRAYED BY A FEE FOR SUCH INFORMATION.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA THAT SUBSEQUENT TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE A FEE OF FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) SHALL BE CHARGED FOR EACH AND EVERY BACKGROUND CHECK RUN ON PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEES AT THE REQUEST OF ANY PRIVATE OR GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYER. THESE FUNDS SHALL FURTHER BE DEPOSITED INTO THE OFFICE OF THE FLOYD COUNTY AUDITOR TO BE USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE EQUIPMENT FUND MONEY 043-99-99-99 COLLECTED BY THE FLOYD COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT SHALL THEREAFTER USE MONIES COLLECTED HEREUNDER FOR POLICE EQUIPMENT OR EDUCATION AS APPROVED BY THE FLOYD COUNTY COUNCIL.
