**Floyd County Board of Commissioners
Ordinance for a Moratorium on Telecommunication Zoning Requests**

Whereas, the Floyd County Board of Commissioners met on March 21, 2017 on this matter pursuant to IC 36-7-4-600 series

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners have authority to adopt a moratorium for a period of time to review and submit revisions for the Floyd County Zoning Ordinance


Whereas, the Floyd County Plan Commission submitted a recommendation to adopt a moratorium for the review of new technologies associated with the telecommunications:


NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED that Floyd County Board of Commissioners hereby directs and orders the Floyd County Plan Commission to have a forty-five day moratorium on the acceptance of any request for a zoning application on telecommunication towers and accessory structures or the adoption of amended language to the Floyd County Zoning Ordinance on this matter.
