

ORDINANCE NO. FCO 2017-7

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE FLOYD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO AMEND
ORDINANCE NO. FCO 2015-14**

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Floyd County have been advised that the Animal Control Authority has reviewed the Ordinance FCO 2015-14 that Replaced the 2007 Animal Ordinance for Floyd County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners wish to amend said Ordinance FCO 2015-14. The section entitled Definitions Generally, Section AO.00 **ENCLOSURES**, 2 (b) shall be replaced with the following: Property enclosed by a buried wire which produces a signal received by a device attached to a collar worn by the animal, and prevents the animal from leaving the property of the owner will be considered a proper enclosure, provided the device and signal are working and the animal does not leave the property unrestrained. The enclosure must contain proper shelter from the weather and a shaded area. This type of enclosure is not acceptable for an unaltered animal, an animal declared a public nuisance or a dangerous animal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

Said section of FCO 2015-14 entitled Definitions Generally, Section AO.00 **ENCLOSURES**, 2 (b) shall be replaced as follows: Property enclosed by a buried wire which produces a signal received by a device attached to a collar worn by the animal, and prevents the animal from leaving the property of the owner will be considered a proper enclosure, provided the device and signal are working and the animal does not leave the property unrestrained. The enclosure must contain proper shelter from the weather and a shaded area. This type of enclosure is not acceptable for an unaltered animal, an animal declared a public nuisance or a dangerous animal.


