ORDINANCE UPDATING AND DIVIDING THE COUNTY OF FLOYD FOUR COUNTY COUNCIL DISTRICTS

WHERAS, the Floyd County Commissioners, in addition to redistricting county commissioners districts (IC 36-2-2-4) and establishing voting precincts (IC 3-11-1.5-2), are ultimately responsible for establishing county council districts; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Commissioners are required to redistrict in 2021 per IC 36-2-3-4(e) following the 2020 census. However, the Floyd County Commissioners may also redistrict County Council Districts in an "odd numbered" year per IC 36-2-3-4(f); and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Commissioners seek to establish County Council districts by adopting an ordinance that describes the districts per IC 36-2-3-4.7; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Commissioners have determined that a good faith effort to improve the proportions and lower the deviation amount the Floyd County's Four (4) County Council election districts is needed; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Commissioners have evaluated the census data and now desire to update County Council election districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Floyd County Board of Commissioners, Floyd County, Indiana make the following changes to the Floyd County Council voting districts:

- (A) The Floyd County Commissioners ordinance shall update as provided herein the changes to the Floyd County Council districts as follows:
 - (1) The County Council shall continue to be divided into four (4) Districts.
 - (2) Pursuant to I.C. 36-2-2-4, the Floyd County Commissioners shall divide the County into four (4) districts that:
 - a. Are composed of contiguous territory;
 - b. Are reasonably compact;
 - c. Do not cross precinct boundary lines;
 - d. Contain, as nearly as possible, equal population. The Floyd County Commissioners in determining population, have relied on U.S. Census Data from the 2020 Census as provided by the State of Indiana. Exhibit "A". All population figures contained in this ordinance are from the aforementioned Data Source.
 - e. The Floyd County Commissioners have attempted to redistrict the County Council boundaries in such a way as to keep all townships whole. Where

the Commissioners have deviated from townships boundaries, it was done in an effort to appropriate the districts populations as equal as possible. In addition, the Commissioners considered population trends in making their final decision.

- (3) The New Districts populations are approximately as follows and the description of the division of the district boundaries are as follows pursuant to IC 36-2-3-4(j): See Exhibit "B".
- (B) The Floyd County Commissioners have prepared a map showing the new boundaries of the districts pursuant to IC 36-2-3-4(h) and has attached as Exhibit "C" hereto for reference;
- (C) The County Executive shall file a copy of the ordinance adopted herein with the Floyd County Circuit Court Clerk pursuant to IC 36-2-3-4.7(b) and a map of the district boundaries shall be filed with the Floyd County Clerk within 30 days of the adoption of this ordinance pursuant to IC 36-2-3-4(h).
- (D) This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage. After passage, the Floyd County Commissioners shall forward this ordinance to the Floyd County Clerk, the Floyd County Auditor, and the Indiana Secretary of State. Pursuant to IC 36-2-4-9, within a reasonable time after an ordinance is adopted, the county auditor shall record it in a book kept for that purpose. The record must include the signature of the presiding officer and the attestation of the auditor. The record, or a certified copy of the record, is presumptive evidence that the ordinance was adopted and took effect.

(E) Pursuant to IC 36-1-6-10, the previously adopted ordinance establishing election districts remains in effect for the purpose of filling a vacancy until the expiration of the term of that office.


