Whereas, the Floyd County Board of Commissioners met on July 5th, 2023 on the matter pursuant to establishing NON-Reverting Funds for the following Floyd County Probation ATOD grant fund – as defined above. The Floyd County Probation Department received funding from ATOD for drug testing supplies and services. The requests are based to ensure clarity, identity, and separation of funding, Floyd County Probation is requesting a home ruled fund to house monies from this funding source.

Whereas, the Board understands Floyd County Probation Department is in need of this fund to establish accordance with the State Board of Accounts.

NOW, THEREFORE,


