## FLOYD COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDINANCE RESCINDING A PORTION OF FCO CHAPTER 92.03(C)

WHEREAS FCO Chapter 92.03(C) prohibits persons to possess, carry, or discharge firearms (unless otherwise allowed by applicable state law).

## WHEREAS IC 35-47-11.1-2 Political subdivision regulation of firearms, ammunition, and firearm accessories prohibited

- Sec. 2. Except as provided in section 4 of this chapter, a political subdivision may not regulate:
  - (1) firearms, ammunition, and firearm accessories;
  - (2) the ownership, possession, carrying, transportation, registration, transfer, and storage of firearms, ammunition, and firearm accessories; and
- (3) commerce in and taxation of firearms, firearm ammunition, and firearm accessories. *As added by P.L.152-2011, SEC.4.*; and

WHEREAS Floyd County deems that portion of the ordinance cited above void.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Commissioners of Floyd County, Indiana, that:

1. FCO Chapter 92.03(C) that prohibits persons to possess, carry, or discharge firearms (unless otherwise allowed by applicable state law) is hereby rescinded and considered void.
