

RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A CUMULATIVE BRIDGE FUND FOR THE BUILDING AND REPAIR OF BRIDGES

Be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd that it is desired and deemed necessary to establish a cumulative bridge fund for the building and repair of bridges and grade separation in Floyd County, Indiana, and to proceed with the proposed plan to establish such fund, and the levying of an additional tax at the rate of Five Cents (5¢) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) on all taxable personal and real property within Floyd County, Indiana, to provide funds for such Cumulative Bridge Fund, said tax to be first levied in 1972, payable in 1973, and annually thereafter for a total not to exceed three (3) years, all as provided by Chapter 299 of the Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana for 1951 as amended.

Be it further resolved that a public hearing on the aforesaid determination of such Board of County Commissioners to establish such Cumulative Bridge Fund be had and held on the 30th day of June, 1972, at the hour of 9:00 A.M. Eastern time, same being 10:00 A.M. Local Time, in the County Commissioners' Room 214 on the second floor of the City County Building, Hauss Square, New Albany, Indiana, and that notice of the holding of said meeting be published in a manner prescribed by law.

Be it further resolved that proof of publication and proof of notices of such public hearing and a certified copy of this resolution and such proposed plan be submitted to the State Board of Tax Commissioners of the State of Indiana, as provided by law.

For the taxpayers of Floyd County, Indiana: You are hereby notified that on the 30th day of June, 1972, the County Commissioners of Floyd County, State of Indiana, pursuant to notice heretofore given and under and by virtue of Chapter 299, Acts of 1951, as amended, duly adopted a plan whereby a Cumulative Bridge Fund was established to provide for the following: Building and repair of bridges and grade separation in Floyd County. Such fund to be provided for by a tax levy of five cents (5¢) on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of taxable real and personal property within said taxing unit, said tax to be levied annually beginning in 1972, payable in 1973, and continuing for a total period of three (3) years, as authorized by said Act. That pursuant to said Act, ten (10) or more taxpayers in said taxing unit, other than those who pay poll tax only, and who will be affected by said tax levy, may file a petition with the County Auditor of Floyd County, not later than ten (10) days after the publication of this notice, setting forth their objections to the proposed levy. 
