




WHEREAS, The General Assembly of the State of Indiana has abolished Daylight Saving Time; and,


WHEREAS, Floyd County is dependent upon the Louisville Metropolitan Area for business purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Louisville, in the State of Kentucky still recognizes Daylight Saving Time;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that one clock located on the first floor of the City-County Building, Hauss Square, New Albany, Floyd County, Indiana, shall be maintained at the official time as prescribed by state law, being Eastern Standard Time, and that the court house hours, effective from 2:00 A.M. on the Fifth Sunday in April until 2:00 A.M. on the Fourth Sunday in October, shall be from 7:00 A.M. Eastern Standard Time to 3:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, and from 7:00 A.M. Eastern Standard Time to 11:00 A.M. Eastern Standard Time on Wednesday and Saturday.
