CONCERNING PROVISION OF SIGNIFICANT FUNDING THROUGH THE TECHNICAL PLANNING ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT FUND

WHEREAS, existing multi-county and regional commissions are presently providing valuable assistance to local units of government in Indiana; and

WHEREAS, there exists a continuing and increasing need for assistance which is being provided by regional and multi-county agencies; and,

WHEREAS, local units of government in Indiana are presently and have in the past provided financial resources for the operation of regional and multi-county agencies; and,

WHEREAS, most units of local government are extremely limited in the amount of financial assistance they are able to provide for the operation of regional and multi-county agencies; and,

WHEREAS, State agencies of Indiana have requested the assistance of multi-county or regional agencies while providing limited or no financial assistance; and,

WHEREAS, there exists a need for additional financial assistance for multi-county and regional agencies in order to cover costs of services provided by said agencies to state agencies; and,

WHEREAS, there exists a need for financial assistance which would allow multi-county and regional agencies the flexibility to respond to various requests of state or local agencies; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners hereby endorses and encourages the provision of significant state financial assistance through the "Technical Planning Assistance to Local Units of Government Fund" as provided by I.C. 18-7-1.5.
