WHEREAS, the Floyd County Engineer has made a thorough investigation of the condition of Bridge Number 23, better known as the Murphy Bridge, located on the Joh Pectol Road, County Road Number 96 over Indian Creek; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, following the receipt of the report of the Floyd County Engineer and upon discussion and investigation has found the condition of the Bridge Number 23 to be such that the health, safety and welfare of the public is presently and will continue to be endangered, unless and until emergency repairs to such structure are effected;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that an extra-ordinary emergency exists with respect to the condition of the Bridge Number 23, and that repairs and improvements to such structure must be undertaken immediately and without further delay;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that formal bidding procedure be dispersed with, in view of the emergency situation and that three bids be invited from at least three or more persons, firms or corporations known to deal in the work required to be done, namely the following: Arthur M. Libs & Sons, Inc., Jack Fulkerson and Erber & Milligan Construction Co., Inc. all, as provided as provided and permitted by the provision of I.C. 5-16-1-1.
