A RESOLUTION EVIDENCING INTENT TO
CREATE AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

WHEREAS, renewed public interest has been expressed on the subject of the creation for Floyd County, Indiana, of an economic development commission to be separate and apart from that created by the Civil City of New Albany, Floyd County, Indiana; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is presently desirous of evidencing its intent with respect to formation of such a commission.

NOW THEREFORE:


BE IT RESOLVED, that upon appropriate finding of the Floyd County Council pursuant to 36-7-12-4, together with other applicable statutes, that the financing of economic development or pollution control facilities necessitates the creation of a department of economic development and subject to the availability of necessary funds, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, shall, upon due consideration, appoint, pursuant to I.C. 36-7-12-7, an economic development commission to act pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-7-12, et. seq.


