WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 12-2-4.5-1, the Auditor of Floyd County has notified the Township Advisory Board of New Albany Township, Floyd County, Indiana, of the fact that the Poor Relief Account for New Albany Township shall be exhausted prior to the end of this fiscal year, with a copy of the letter of notification of the Auditor of Floyd County being appended hereto and made a part of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 12-2-4.5-1, the Township Advisory Board of New Albany Township, Floyd County, Indiana, has elected to exercise its right to appeal for the authority to borrow money, on a short-term basis, to fund poor relief services in New Albany Township, Floyd County, Indiana, with a copy of the Resolution of the Advisory Board of New Albany Township being appended hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, at a special meeting duly called by Member Douglas Bierman, pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of I.C. 36-2-2-8, has determined, pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 12-2-4.5-2, that sufficient funds are not available within the County General Fund or other fund to make a loan to the Township Advisory Board of New Albany Township, Floyd County, Indiana, to enable the Advisory Board to fund poor relief services in New Albany Township, as requested.

NOW THEREFORE:

Township be, and hereby is advised by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 12-2-4.5-2, that sufficient funds do not exist in the general fund of Floyd County, Indiana, or other funds to permit a loan or advancements sufficient to enable the Advisory Board of New Albany Township, Floyd County, Indiana, to fund poor relief services in New Albany Township, as such requirements are more particularly set forth in a Resolution of the Advisory Board of New Albany Township, dated the Advisory Board of New Albany Township, dated the Advisory Board of New Albany Township, Floyd County, Indiana, for such a loan or advancement is denied.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor of Floyd County, Indiana, in accordance with the provisions of I.C. 12-2-4.5-3, be and is hereby directed to transmit the formal funding request of the Advisory Board of New Albany Township, Floyd County, Indiana, together with a copy of this Resolution to the Floyd
