

FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION  
NO. 1984- 84-6

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 11-12-2, the State of Indiana has made available to local communities funds to develop a coordinated local corrections-criminal justice system to provide an effective alternative to imprisonment at the state level; and

WHEREAS, in order to qualify for such funds as may, from time to time, become available, it is necessary for the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd to establish a community corrections advisory board pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 11-12-2-2.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd does hereby establish and create the Floyd County Community Corrections Advisory Board, said board to consist of the following members:

- (a) The Floyd County Sheriff;
- (b) The Prosecuting Attorney for the 52nd Judicial Circuit, Floyd County, Indiana;
- (c) The Director of the Floyd County Welfare Department;
- (d) The Mayor of the Civil City of New Albany, Floyd County, Indiana;
- (e) One Judge of a Court having criminal jurisdiction, to be appointed by the Judge of the 52nd Judicial Circuit, Floyd County, Indiana;
- (f) One Judge having juvenile jurisdiction, to be appointed by the Judge of the 52nd Judicial Circuit, Floyd County, Indiana;
- (g) One licensed attorney having a substantial criminal defense practice, to be appointed by the Judge of the 52nd Judicial Circuit, Floyd County, Indiana;
- (h) One probation officer to be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd;



(i) One educational administrator to be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd;

(j) One representative of a private correctional agency, if such an agency exists in Floyd County, Indiana, such representative to be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd;

(k) One mental health administrator, or if none is available in Floyd County, one psychiatrist or one psychologist, or one physician, said individual to be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd;

(l) One ex-offender to be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd;

(m) Four lay persons, at least one of whom must be a member of a minority race, with said lay persons to be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that those members of the Floyd County Community Corrections Advisory Board to be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd shall be appointed for a term of four (4) years; the criminal defense attorney shall be appointed for a term of four (4) years; and, other members of the Advisory Board shall serve only while holding the office or position held at the time of appointment.
