

FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION 1991-7

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FLOYD COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICIES

WHEREAS, by resolution No. 1981-11, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd adopted certain personnel policies; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is desirous of amending said policies in the particulars as hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the provisions of the paragraph of the Floyd County Personnel Policies entitled MILITARY LEAVE, as adopted by Resolution No. 1981-11 be, and they hereby are, amended to read as follows:

MILITARY LEAVE

All officers and employees who are members of a National Guard unit or the reserve component of the naval, air, or ground forces of the United States shall be entitled to leave of absence, without pay, from their respective duties for such time as such employees are in the military service on training duties under the order of the governing authority thereof, PROVIDED, those full-time officers and employees who are on extended leave of absence for military training (herein defined as a period of at least five consecutive working days) shall receive as compensation, for a period not to exceed ten days in any calendar year, a sum equal to the difference between the employee's regular pay and the military pay to which the employee becomes entitled by reason of such extended leave, as such regular pay and military pay are computed on a daily basis, and PROVIDED, such compensation for extended leave shall be payable only if the employee's regular rate of compensation exceeds the military rate.
