

FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 1994-VI

WHEREAS: It has been brought to the attention of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd that public postage was used, through inadvertence, oversight, or otherwise, by the Administrator of Floyd Memorial Hospital in connection with fund raising efforts on behalf of a candidate for public office; and

WHEREAS: While the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd shall continue to foster active participation by all county employees in the political process, such encouragement must, nonetheless, be tempered by the awareness that public resources, whether funds, materials, or personnel, shall not be used for purely political activities and in violation of the public trust.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that all county employees and all citizens of Floyd County be, and they hereby are, encouraged to actively participate in the political processes of their federal, state, and local governments; support the candidates of their choice; and, to vote on Tuesday, May 3, 1994.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all county employees should undertake their participation in the political process with the knowledge and understanding that public resources shall not be used for purely political purposes in violation of the public trust.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be delivered to the Board of Trustees of Floyd Memorial Hospital for such action as it may deem appropriate in accordance therewith.
