

FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION 1996-V

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE EXTENSION OF SANITARY SEWERS IN CERTAIN AREAS OF NORTHEASTERN FLOYD COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is aware that the residents of certain subdivisions and developments in the northeastern portion of Floyd County, Indiana, as this 'affected area' is more particularly depicted in Exhibit "A" to this resolution, have been, for many years, plagued with inoperative septic tanks due to impermeable soils; and

WHEREAS, as the result of recent residential development and the installation of sanitary sewer mains and facilities in the unincorporated areas of northeastern Floyd County, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd reasonably believes that the replacement of inoperable private disposal systems through the extension of sanitary sewers might prove to be financially feasible; and

WHEREAS, subject to the approval of the Floyd County Council, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is desirous of expending not more that \$50,000.00 of available CEDIT revenues for the purpose of retaining the services of an engineering consultant to determine the financial feasibility of extending sanitary sewers to the affected area and, if feasible, to design the system necessary to provide sewage disposal services to the affected area; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is mindful of the fact that the final disposal facility for the sewage system presently contemplated is owned and operated by the Civil City of New Albany, Indiana, acting by and through its duly constituted and acting Sewer Board, and the Board of Commissioners is desirous, by this resolution, of requesting a determination by such Sewer Board of the existence of sufficient capacity in the New Albany Waste Water Treatment Plant to accept the effluent of the contemplated sewage disposal system if constructed, and is further desirous of obtaining a firm commitment, by such officials, officers, boards or commissions having jurisdiction, of a willingness to accept such effluent for final disposal upon reasonable terms and conditions to be agreed.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED, that, by copy of this resolution, the Sewer Board of the City of New Albany be, and it hereby is, respectfully requested to determine whether or not the present or expected future capacity of the New Albany Wastewater Treatment Plant is sufficient to accept for

final treatment and disposal the effluent generated by approximately 275 single family residential structures located within the area(s) depicted in Exhibit "A" to this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, by copy of this resolution, the Mayor, Common Council, and Sewer Board of the City of New Albany, Indiana, together with any other officer, official, board or commission of said city having jurisdiction, be, and they hereby are, respectfully requested to advise the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, in writing, as to whether or not the effluent generated by the system contemplated and to be designed would be accepted for disposal by the New Albany Wastewater Treatment Plant upon terms and conditions to be mutually agreed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Floyd County Auditor be, and she hereby is, directed, upon adoption of this resolution, to deliver a copy hereof the Mayor of the City of New Albany, the president of the Common Council of said city, and to the presiding officer of the New Albany Sewer Board.

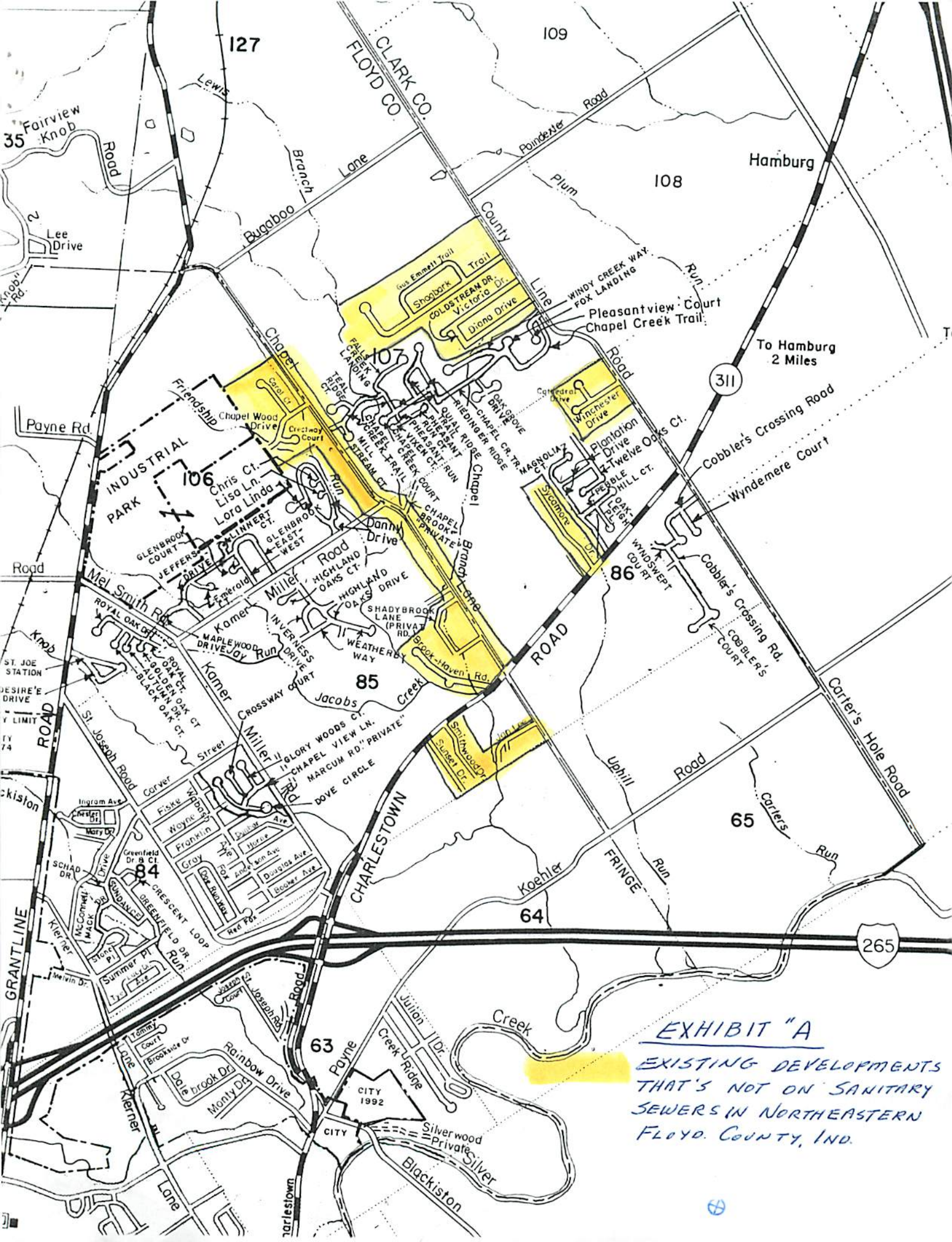


EXHIBIT "A"
