A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE CONSIDERATION OF A LOCATION FOR A  
NEW ANIMAL SHELTER

WHEREAS, the Civil City of New Albany, the County of Floyd, and the Floyd County Animal Rescue League, Incorporated, have concluded an agreement pertaining the construction and operation of an Animal Shelter; and

WHEREAS, prior to the execution of said agreement, the Floyd County Animal Rescue League, Incorporated, has caused the real estate commonly known as 213-217 West Market Street, New Albany, Indiana, to be properly zoned for animal shelter purposes, with said real estate being owned by the New Albany-Floyd County Building Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is presently desirous by this resolution of endorsing the consideration of said real as a possible site for the construction of the new Animal Shelter.


NOW THEREFORE:
