

FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION 1999- VII  
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FUNDING OF THE  
FLOYD COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Solid Waste Management District has formulated its budget for fiscal year 1999, which budget has been approved or is pending approval by those local and state entities and agencies having jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is presently receiving revenues from the Clark-Floyd Landfill located in Bennettsville, Clark County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, to assist the District in meeting its financial obligations and to avoid the necessity of imposing a property tax upon the residents of Floyd County for District purposes, is desirous of granting funds to the District pursuant to the provisions of IC 13-9.5-2-11.7.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED, that subject to the approval of the Floyd County Council, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd does hereby authorize and make a grant of funds to the Floyd County Solid Waste Management District in the amount of \$200,000.00 from the Floyd County Landowners Liability and Contingency Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the approval of this grant of funds by the Floyd County Council, the Floyd County Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to transfer said funds to the account of the District.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is presently receiving revenues from the Clark-Floyd-Perryton Joint Utility in proportion to population; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd do assert the District's inability to implement a budgetary plan to avoid bankruptcy for the District unless it is the responsibility of the District to furnish to the provisions of IC 10-3-3-1ff.


NOW THEREFORE:


BE IT RESOLVED, That subject to the availability of the Floyd County Government, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd does hereby authorize and make a trust of funds to the Floyd County Solid Waste Management District to the sum of \$2500,000.00 from the Floyd County Parks and Recreation Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon the availability of this sum of funds by the Floyd County Government, the Floyd County Government is directed to disperse said funds to the second of the District, and further is directed to disperse said funds to the second of the District.
