## FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION 2000- XV A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE MANAGEMENT OF STORM WATER IN CERTAIN AREAS OF FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of IC 36-9-28.5-2 the legislative of each county shall, by ordinance or resolution, on or before January 1, 2001, establish a policy for the management of storm water runoff from developed real property under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, being the legislative body for Floyd County, Indiana, is desirous by this resolution of establishing a policy for the management of storm water runoff from all real property in Floyd County which is not located within a municipality.

## NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, than it is and shall be the policy of Floyd County, Indiana, with respect to all territory not located within the corporate boundaries of the City of New Albany or the towns of Georgetown and Greenville, Indiana, that, to the extent possible, and consistent with applicable zoning, building, and subdivision regulations, storm water runoff from developed real estate shall be retained, collected, contained and/or dispersed upon the premises; or if such retention, collection, containment or dispersal is not possible or feasible, that such storm water runoff be directed into natural and existing drains, channels, creeks, and streams in such a manner as to minimize damage to adjacent and adjoining properties; or if the direction of storm water runoff into such naturally existing structures is not possible or feasible, that there be constructed such storm water drains, sewers, structures or facilities as may be reasonably necessary to prevent undue damage to adjacent and adjoining real estate and to promote the health, safety, and comfort of the general public.
