

FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION 2005-XVIII

**A RESOLUTION PERMITTING THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO
TOWN OF LANESVILLE, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Sheriff has advised the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd (Board) that one of his patrol vehicles is no longer needed and necessary for law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, the town board of Lanesville, Indiana has indicated its desire to acquire said vehicles for use by the Lanesville Town Marshall and has proposed the payment of the sum of \$3,000.00 for the vehicles.

WHEREAS, the provisions of IC 36-1-11-8 permit the transfer of property between governmental entities for any amount of real property, cash, or other personal property as agreed by such entities; and

WHEREAS, for the price and under the terms agreed to, the Board is desirous of transferring said vehicle to the Town Of Lanesville, Indiana

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that upon the adoption by the Town Board Of Lanesville of a substantially identical resolution, the following described vehicles be transferred to the Town Of Lanesville, Indiana:

- (1) One 1998 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN 2FAFP71W3WX147253
- (1) One 1998 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN 2FAFP71WXWX147251

upon the payment of \$3,000.00 to the Floyd County Auditor for said vehicles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon receipt and upon approval by the Floyd County Council, the funds received for said vehicle be transferred to account No. 0101-005-2000-04.


