WHEREAS, the Board is desirous of further amending said ordinance and, in particular, that prior referenced amendment thereto pertaining to construction site runoff; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-7-4-607, if a proposed amendment to the zoning ordinance originates with the county executive, it must be referred to the Commission for hearing, consideration, and recommendation prior to any final action thereon; and

WHEREAS, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October, 2005, the proposed amendments were forwarded to the Commission for its action in accordance with applicable statutes; and

WHEREAS, following a public hearing thereon, the proposed amendments were certified by the Commission to the Board as provided by the provisions of IC 36-7-4. et seq; and

WHEREAS, the Board is desirous by this resolution of approving the proposed amendments as certified by the Commission.

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the recitals set forth above be incorporated herein and made a part of this Resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the proposed amendment of Floyd County Ordinance A67-4, as certified by the Commission, the same amending the present form of the Ordinance and adding an Article thereto entitled POST-CONSTRUCTION STORM WATER MANAGEMENT, be, and the same hereby is approved.
