

Floyd County Resolution 2007- XXV

**A RESOLUTION PERMITTING THE TRANSFER OF
CERTAIN PROPERTY TO CRAWFORD COUNTY, INDIANA**

WHEREAS the Floyd County Sheriff has advised the Board of Commissioners of the County Floyd (Board), State of Indiana that one of his patrol vehicles is no longer needed and necessary for law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners of the County of Crawford has indicated its desire to acquire said vehicle for use by the Crawford County Sheriff and has proposed the payment of \$ 3,600 for the vehicle.

WHEREAS the provisions of IC 36-1-11-8 permit the transfer of property between governmental entities for any amount of real property, cash or other personal property as agreed by such entities; and

WHEREAS for the price and under the terms agreed to, the Board is desirous of transferring said vehicle to Crawford County, Indiana.

NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED that upon the adoption by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Crawford of a substantially identical resolution, the following described vehicle is to be transferred to Crawford County, Indiana:

Upon the payment of \$ 3,600 to the Floyd County Auditor for said vehicle.


