

FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION 2011- 1X

RESOLUTION PERMITTING DISPOSITION OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY BY THE FLOYD COUNTY SHERIFF

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Sheriff has an occasional need to dispose of, or transfer certain surplus personal property; and

WHEREAS, IC 5-22-22 et seq allows for the disposition of surplus personal property by a governmental body and;

WHEREAS, IC 5-22-22-6 specifically allows for the public or private sale or transfer of surplus personal property without advertising for a single item, with an estimated value of less than \$1,000.00; or more than one item with an estimated total value of less than \$5,000.00 and allows for the sale of the property at public or private sale or transfer of the property without the requirement of advertising; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Sheriff is desirous of selling or transferring certain surplus personal property now in his possession pursuant to I.C. 5-22-22-6, which includes but is not limited to automobiles


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners, that the Floyd County Sheriff is hereby enabled to dispose of surplus personal property pursuant to IC 5-22-22- et seq which provides that the Sheriff may sell or transfer surplus personal property with an estimated value of less than \$1,000.00; or more than one item of surplus personal property with an estimated total value of less than \$5,000.00, without advertising the sale or transfer of said personal property.
