A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF EFFORTS TO REOPEN K&I BRIDGE FOR PUBLIC USE

WHEREAS from its founding in 1813 to its Two Hundredth anniversary today, Floyd County's identity is inextricably linked to the Ohio River and;

WHEREAS, in Indiana, the counties of Clark and Floyd have made great progress on the Ohio River Greenway, Louisville offers the well-established and extensive River Walk and both of these features offer the benefit of exercise, outdoor activity and observing nature along the great waterway and;

WHEREAS, the Big Four Bridge between Jeffersonville and Louisville is nearing completion as a link between those two river paths and the cities they serve and;

WHEREAS the opportunity exists for further beneficial use of these outstanding community resources which are available amenities for our citizens, by a progressive plan to incorporate the former automobile decks of the K&I Bridge into cross-river link of the Ohio River Greenway in New Albany with the River Walk in Louisville and;

WHEREAS the railroad corporation controlling the K&I Bridge, Norfolk Southern, has shown intransigence against allowing the citizens of the neighboring communities of Louisville and Floyd County to beneficially use this long-standing resource as a link of the River Walk and the Greenway and;

WHEREAS continuation of the state of semi-abandonment of the K&I Bridge, due to its solely as a railroad facility, creates a blight on the Uptown Neighborhood and:

WHEREAS responsible stewardship of the K&I Bridge could provide not only a link between Louisville and Floyd County for the amenities previously noted, but could also provide a vital emergency link between the two cities and;

Now, THEREFORE the Floyd County Commissioners, by this resolution do express support for its efforts to begin the process of convincing the Norfolk Southern Railroad of New Albany see the K&I Bridge as a community resource and one which should be available to the community for its beneficial use.
