Resolution to Vacate FCR – VIII and FCR – VI

Whereas the Floyd County Commissioners and the Floyd County Council passed FCR 2008-VIII on May 7, 2008 for the purpose of sharing an IT employee with the City of New Albany.

Whereas the Floyd County Commissioners passed FCR 2009 – VI establishing a Board to oversee the combining of the City of New Albany and Floyd County computer networks. The parties approved an IT Director and an IT Technical position. Funding for the project shall be approved by the fiscal bodies and shall be evenly divided between the parties. Either party may terminate this agreement with 90 days written notice to the other party.

Whereas the parties have decided to handle their computer networks separately and each be responsible for their own employees.

Wherefore, be it RESOLVED that the Floyd County Commissioners formally vacate FCR – VIII and FCR – VI. The Floyd County Commissioners shall immediately serve the City of New Albany a copy of this resolution to serve as formal written notice of the termination of the Agreement described herein between the Floyd County Commissioners and the City of New Albany.


