

Floyd County Resolution 2017 – 5

A RESOLUTION PERMITTING THE TRANSFER OF PROPERTY TO CLARK COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS; the Floyd County Sheriff has advised the Floyd County Board of Commissioners that one (1) of the Sheriff patrol vehicles are no longer needed and necessary for law enforcement purposes: and

WHEREAS; the County of Clark, Indiana has indicated their desire to acquire said vehicles for use by the Clark County Sheriff and has proposed the payment of the sum of four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500.00) for the vehicle.

WHEREAS; the provisions of Indiana Code 36-1-11-8 permit the transfer of property between government entities for any amount of real property, cash or personal property as agreed by such entities; and

WHEREAS; for the price and under the terms agreed to, the Board of Commissioner's is desirous of transferring said vehicles to the Clark County Sheriff, Indiana.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED; that upon the adoption by the Floyd County Board of Commissioners the following described vehicle will be transferred to the Sheriff of Clark County, Indiana.

2011 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor vin # 2FABP7BV4BX137698

Upon payment of four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500.00) to the Floyd County Sheriff for said vehicle.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon receipt of said funds and upon the approval of the Floyd County Council for an appropriation request, the funds will be deposited for said vehicles into the Sheriff's Special Vehicle and Equipment Fund (4910).




