**RESOLUTION OF FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA AND
HIGHLANDER FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT BOARD
REGARDING THE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Highlander Fire Protection District Board (hereinafter referred to as "Highlander") owns personal property, two (2) older Ambulances with VIN # 1FDUF4HT1NEE70968 (year 2022) and 1FDUF4HT7PED60283 (year 2023) as well as a 2026 Ambulance with VIN # 1FDUF4HT3SEC11412.

WHEREAS, Floyd County, Indiana (hereinafter referred to as "Floyd County") is desirous of having the vehicles for the use of EMS services pursuant to the Interlocal with the Floyd County Fire Territory.

WHEREAS, Floyd County will pay the balance owed on the 2026 Ambulance upon transfer into Floyd County's name.

WHEREAS, Highlander and Floyd County agree that Highlander can continue to use all three (3) ambulances until close of business on December 31, 2026 at which time they shall transfer possession to Floyd County.

WHEREAS, Highlander shall maintain sufficient insurance coverage on all three (3) ambulances during the use of the ambulances and shall indemnify and hold Floyd County harmless in relation to any claim associated with Highlander's use, operation, maintenance, or otherwise of the ambulances during the time of use.

WHEREAS, Highlander wishes to transfer said property to Floyd County and Floyd County desires to have said property.

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-1-11-8 authorizes the transfer or exchange of property between governmental entities upon terms and conditions agreed upon by the entities as evidenced by the adoption of a substantially identical resolution by the governing body of each entity.

WHEREAS, Highlander and Floyd County find, pursuant to Indiana Code 36-1-11-8, that the transfer of said property to Floyd County is appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA, AND THE HIGHLANDER FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT BOARD:

1. It is hereby considered and resolved that the Highlander Fire Protection District Board transfer of Highlander's interest in the two (2) older Ambulances with VIN # 1FDUF4HT1NEE70968 (year 2022) and 1FDUF4HT7PED60283 (year 2023) as well as the 2026 Ambulance with VIN #1FDUF4HT3SEC11412 to Floyd County, Indiana is hereby approved.
2. The President of the Highlander Fire Protection District Board is authorized to sign title over to Floyd County, Indiana upon approval of this Resolution by all parties.

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REGARDING THE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL PROPERTY**

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WHEREAS, Highlander and Floyd County find, pursuant to Indiana Code 36-1-11-8, that the transfer of said property to Floyd County is appropriate.

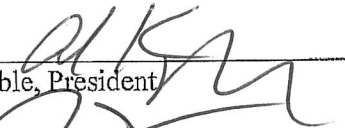

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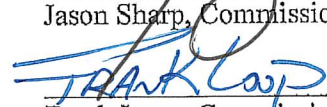
3. Floyd County will pay the balance owed on the 2026 Ambulance upon transfer into Floyd County's name.
