## **Program Maintenance:**

Approval of Minutes – April 1 2024

4201 Mel Smith Road (Amanda Steinberg) - Flooding/Drainage Issue

Ms. Steinberg came before the Board to request help in ending a flooding/drainage issue she is experiencing on her property at 4201 Mel Smith Road, New Albany. Ms. Steinberg believes the cause for the water issues is due to the water runoff from The Church on the Rocks property and the Collin Receveur apartment complex that is near her property. Ms. Steinberg explained she purchased her property last fall and has now starter experiencing these flooding issues.

The Board discussed the issue with Ms. Steinberg and asked if she has contacted Mr. Recevuer about the problems she is having and if not she should contact him. Mr. Knable suggested that someone from the County should contact Mr. Receveur also.
