CONSTITUTIONAL QUESTION NUMBER 1 - Registration

Proposed Amendment to Section 14 of Article 2 All general elections shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November; but township elections may be held at such time as may be provided by law; Provided, That the general assembly may provide by law for the election of all judges of courts of general or appellate jurisdiction, by an election to be held for such officer only, at which time no other officer shall be voted for; and also provide for the registration of all persons entitled to vote. In providing for the registration of persons entitled to vote the general assembly shall have power to classify the several counties, townships, cities and towns of the state into classes, and to enact laws prescribing a uniform method of registration in any or all of such classes.

CONSTITUTIONAL QUESTION NUMBER 2 - Apportionment

Proposed Amendment to Section 4 and 5 of Article 4

Section 4. The general assembly shall during the period between the general election in the year 1928 and the convening of the legislature in 1929, and every sixth year thereafter, cause to be ascertained the number of votes cast for all of the candidates for secretary of state in the different counties at the last preceding general election.

Section 5. The number of senators and representatives shall, at the session next following each period when the number of votes cast for the office of secretary of state shall be ascertained, be fixed by law, and apportioned among the several counties, according to the number of votes cast for all of the candidates for the office of secretary of state at such last preceding general election.

CONSTITUTIONAL QUESTION NUMBER 3 - Salaries, Terms - Increase

Proposed Amendment to Section 2 of Article 15 When the duration of any office is not provided for by this constitution, it may be declared by law; and if not so declared, such office shall be held during the pleasure of the authority making the appointment. But the general assembly shall not create any office, the tenure of which shall be longer than four (4) years, nor shall the term of office or salary of any officer fixed by this constitution or by law be increased during the term for which such officer was elected or appointed.
