CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT #2

That Section 11 of Article 7 of the Constitution of the State of Indiana be amended to read as follows: "Sec. 11 There shall be elected in each judicial circuit by the voters thereof a prosecuting attorney, who shall hold his office for four years, and whose term of office shall begin on the first day of January next succeeding his election. The election of prosecuting attorneys under this section shall be held at the time of holding the general election in the year 1954 and each four years thereafter: Provided, that any such officer whose term is abridged by vitrue of the section shall continue to serve until January 1, 1959."

Shall the term of Prosecuting Attorney in each county be increased from (2) two to (4) four years by constitutional amendment? This amendment submitted pursuant to Chapter 208 of the Acts of the 84th session and Chapter 92 of the Acts of the 87th session of the Indiana General Assembly.
