Shall Article 4, Sections 9 and 29 of the Indiana Constitution be amended to permit the General Assembly to establish the length and frequency of its sessions by law? This amendment proposes to eliminate the restrictions from the Constitution on length (61 calendar days) and frequency (biennial) of legislative sessions and substitute limitations fixed by state law?

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NUMBER 2

Shall Article 7 (Judicial) of the Constitution of the State of Indiana be repealed and re-enacted to change the present Constitution as follows: Reorganize the Supreme Court and a Court of Appeals; create the office of Chief Justicel provide for appointment of such judges by Governorfrom lists of nominees names by a non-partisan commission; provide for the approval of rejection of such judges by the voters after 2 years of service and every 10 years thereafter; provide a system for discipline and removal of judges; permit the General Assembly to determine the qualifications, jurisdiction and tenure of Justices of the Peace; and require prosecuting attorneys to be lawyers?
