IN THE MATTER OF OLD BUSINESS:

2024 Council Meeting Schedule

Council President Roberts discussed the 2024 Council Meeting Schedule with the Council Members. Councilman Faulkner stated that pushing the budget approval meeting back would delay the Auditor's Office in finalizing the budget. Councilwoman Lake stated that there is more transparency when the budget approval meeting is separate from the regular meetings but also said that the meeting at either time would work for her. Auditor Secrease stated that it does make it more difficult to combine the October regular meeting with the adoption meeting and that it would be easier to keep the meetings separate. President Roberts stated that he would not mind one less meeting. Councilman Alexander stated that he is okay to come in an extra day to make it easier for the Auditor's Office. Councilman Maple, Cuthbert, and Sanders stated that they were fine with keeping the schedule the way it is. Councilman Alexander stated that he wants to keep the August meeting separate from the budget hearings. Councilman Faulkner made a motion to keep the 2024 Council Meeting Schedule as it was presented and to approve it; Councilman Alexander seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF NEW BUSINESS:

Sheriff Department Updates

Sheriff Asher stated that the Sheriff's Department will have two full-time Mental Health Therapists at the jail starting in the new year. He stated that they are missing peer coaching in the jail, and to make up for that missing piece, they will be working with the Integrated Reentry and Correctional Support (IRACS) Program starting in 2024.

Sheriff Asher also stated that they will have a drug dog starting at the jail in 2024 with the help of the Prosecutor's Office. The dog will be checking the mail, employees, and things throughout the jail for drug trafficking.

The Sheriff's Department will be hosting Christmas Behind Bars at the jail with the help of several churches on December 9th. Sheriff Asher also thanked the Correctional Officers who helped with security at We Care the previous weekend.

Sheriff Asher thanked Highway Engineer Amber Tolle for all the help with installing gas lines from one building to another.

Sheriff Asher also stated that two Deputies have left the County for outside employment in the private sector. He stated that they are still trying to fill a few positions throughout the department.

Integrated Reentry and Correctional Support (IRACS) Program

Sheriff Asher introduced Jaime Whitaker from the Integrated Reentry and Correctional Support (IRACS) Program to present to the Council about the program and how they are going to implement within the jail starting in January 2024.

Council Appointments

Pam Isacc presented the following Council Appointments for 2024: Donna Graham for the Greentown Public Library, Russell Hopkins for the Board of Zoning Appeals, and Beth Harshman for the Alcohol and Beverage Commission. Councilman Faulkner made a motion to approve the Council Appointments as read, Councilwoman Lake seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Ordinance No. 2023-HCCO-52 - Recorder's Record Perpetuation Fund

Recorder Torie Kelley presented the Council with her Recorder's Record Perpetuation Fund Ordinance. This allows her to appropriate money to supplement her office for the coming year. Councilman Alexander made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 2023-HCCO-52 – Recorder's Records Perpetuation Fund as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilman Sanders, and the motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF COUNCIL BUSINESS:

Councilman Lake discussed a meeting that herself, Councilman Faulkner, and Councilman Sanders attended at Ivy Tech that was called Government 101. She said it was a great meeting and very informative. Councilman Faulkner stated that it was an excellent meeting and that it was targeted towards newly elected individuals. Councilman Faulkner believes that the Council should have a financial advisor that they can have access to. Councilwoman Lake stated the Councilman Sanders thought it would be a good idea to have a five-year plan for the Council.

Council President Roberts thanked the Council members for a successful year and that he looks forward to working with them in 2024.

There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, the meeting was adjourned at 5:20 p.m. on a motion made by Councilwoman Lake.

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2024-HCCO-01

WHEREAS, there has been established by Indiana Law (I.C. 33-40-3-1) a fund within each county to be known as the Supplemental Public Defender Services Fund; and

WHEREAS, Howard County has established a Supplemental Public Defender Services Fund, which accumulates revenue from person who have been appointed the Public Defender in Howard County; and

WHEREAS, it is required that the Howard County Council appropriate funds from said Fund for use by the Howard County Public Defender to supplement the Howard County Public Defender budget which has been established for the year 2024; and

WHEREAS, funds from the Supplemental Public Defender Fund are to be used only to supplement the provisions for court-appointed legal services and are not to be used to replace other funding of court-appointed legal services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of Howard County that those funds collected by the Auditor of Howard County in the fund known as the Howard County Public Defender Supplemental Fund shall be used to supplement existing budget of the Howard County Public Defender for the year 2024 for purposes and expenses to provide better quality services and more services available to those persons who have been appointed legal counsel in Howard County. These expenditures may be for items designated at the discretion of the Howard County Public Defender including, but not limited to, equipment, special court reporter expenses, contract attorney expenses, travel expenses, witness fees, expert witness fees, expert witness analysis, investigation, seminar expenses, continuing legal education, both in Indiana and outside of Indiana, subscriptions, office expenses, computers, copiers, fax machines, i-Pads, cell phones, and for any other purposes deemed appropriate by the Howard County Public Defender consistent with I.C. 33-40-3.

FUTHERMORE, the expenditures from said Fund shall be made by the Howard County Auditor and Treasurer of Howard County upon submission to the Auditor of a claim form indicating the service, equipment, supply, or other item of expenditure, which will be paid by the Treasurer of Howard County upon receipt of said claim without the need for ordinary advertising as other claims submitted for payment from the General Fund.
