

MARTIN COUNTY GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 1991- 1

A proposal for a general ordinance establishing the Law Enforcement Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MARTIN COUNTY COUNCIL OF MARTIN COUNTY, Indiana:

LAW ENFORCEMENT FUND

Section 1.

(a) There is hereby created a "Law Enforcement Fund." The fund shall consist of deposits in the form of voluntary surrender fees, reimbursement for restitution and other law enforcement related fees recovered by the office of the Martin County Prosecutor which are not required to be deposited in the County General Fund.

(b) The Law Enforcement Fund shall be appropriated for funding activities recovered by I.C. §34-4-30.1 and I.C. §34-4-30.5 and liquidation of personal or real property obtained from criminal defendants.

(c) Monies from this fund shall be subject to appropriation in accordance with IC 36-2-5-2.

(d) All money collected under this section shall be transferred to the County Treasurer who shall deposit said funds and disburse as the Prosecuting Attorney directs. Any money remaining in the fund at the end of the year does not revert to any other fund but shall continue in the Law Enforcement Fund.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and compliance with IC 36-2-4-8.
