A RESOLUTION OF
THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MARTIN COUNTY, STATE OF INDIANA,
WAIVING REQUIREMENT OF STANDARD PERFORMANCE BOND FOR
CONTRACT FOR GENERAL REASSESSMENT TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Martin, State of Indiana, has determined, pursuant to the recommendation of the County Assessor and Township Assessors of the the County, to let bids pursuant to specifications for general reassessment technical assistance for the general reassessment commencing July, 1993, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires, as a part of the bidding and contracting process for technical assistance for said general reassessment, to offer an alternative of securing contract performance by a 35% retainage of the contractor's fees until satisfactory completion of the contract or by a standard performance bond with corporate surety,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MARTIN, STATE OF INDIANA, that the requirement of posting a standard performance bond from a corporate surety by a successful bidder or the contractor for general technical assistance for the reassessment commencing July, 1993, is hereby waived, and the successful bidder or contractor for said services shall secure contract performance by either standard performance bond with corporate surety or by 35% retainage of fees until satisfactory completion of the contract.
