

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-24

A RESOLUTION OF
THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OR
MARTIN COUNTY, STATE OF INDIANA,
DECLARING FLOOD EMERGENCY IN MARTIN COUNTY, IN

WHEREAS, the East Fork of the White River and its tributaries are now out-of-bank in Martin County, IN, due to recent weather conditions and the amount of precipitation received in Martin County and throughout the State of Indiana,; and

WHEREAS, certain areas of Martin County are now flooded and certain county roads are now blocked by flood water preventing clear road access to those areas in the event of a medical or other emergency; and

WHEREAS, the East Fork of the White River including its tributaries, are expected to crest in Martin County during the ensuing week of November 21 through November 26, 1993; and

WHEREAS, prediction of future weather and river conditions are uncertain;

IT IS, THEREFORE, RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MARTIN COUNTY, STATE OF INDIANA:

Martin County, IN, is declared to be operating under emergency conditions, and the Martin County Civil Defense/Emergency Management are placed on alert.

All calls relating to flooding or flood conditions, whether immediate, imminent or threatening, or emergencies resulting therefrom shall be made to and received by Martin County Civil Defense/Emergency Management at Martin County Sheriff's Department, Martin County Security Center, Shoals, IN.

ADOPTED this 20th of November, 1993, at Shoals, Martin County, Indiana.

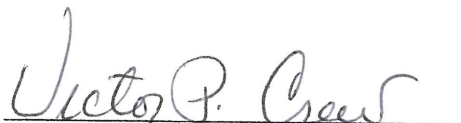
