

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MARTIN COUNTY
CORRECTIONS FUND
ORDINANCE NUMBER 94-2

WHEREAS, State Enrolled Act Number 395, passed by the General Assembly during the regular session of the Indiana Legislature in 1986, added to the Statutes of the State of Indiana, I.C. 11-12-6, et seq. provide for the establishment and funding of a county corrections fund; and

WHEREAS, I.C. 11-12-6-6 provides that any County may annually adopt an Ordinance to elect to receive deposits from the State Department of Correction and to establish a County Corrections Fund; and

WHEREAS, the County Corrections Fund may be used only for funding the operation of the County Jail, Jail Programs, or other local correctional facilities; and

WHEREAS, the County in concurring with this Ordinance may elect to receive deposits from the State Department of Corrections and establish a County Corrections Fund and receive deposits at either Level 1, Level 2, or Level 3 Funding; and

WHEREAS, Level 3 is the most appropriate level of participation for Martin County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MARTIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, as shall be hereafter further adopted and passed by the Martin County Commissioners as follows;

Section 1. The Martin County Auditor is hereby authorized to receive deposits from the Department of Corrections in accordance with I.C. 11-2-6, et seq. as the County Commissioners and County Council shall by this Ordinance elect to receive same in accordance with said Statute.

Section 2. That the County does hereby elect to receive such deposits at Level 3 Funding for the year 1994.

Section 3. That there is hereby created a "Martin County Corrections Fund" to be administered by the Martin County Sheriff. The Fund shall consist of deposits received from the Department of Corrections in accordance with I.C. 1101206, et seq.

Section 4. The Martin County Corrections Fund may be used only for funding the operation of the County Jail, Jail Programs, and other local correctional facilities. Any monies remaining in the Martin County Corrections Fund at the end of the year shall not revert to any other fund, but remain in said Martin County Correction Fund for use as specified in the Statute regarding same and as hereinabove set forth, and shall not require a notice of encumbrance but retention shall be automatic and in accordance with Title 11 of the Statutes of the State of Indiana.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Martin County Commissioners.

Dear Sheriff Gee:

This letter is a reminder that county legislative bodies desiring to participate in the County Corrections Fund, 1.C 11-12-6, must adopt a county ordinance signifying their intent **prior to May 1 of each year.**

In order to participate in the disbursement of these funds for the 1994-95 fiscal year the county ordinance **must be enacted and filed with the Secretary of State prior to May 1, 1994.**

Per the statute, **two (2)** copies of the ordinance need to be provided to the Secretary of State. It is recommended that you send these copies to the attention of John Koenig, Secretary of State's Office, 201 Statehouse, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204.

You and the county commissioners are encouraged to participate in the County Corrections Fund and to have your county ordinance filed as soon as practical.
