

ORDINANCE NO. 1994-3

AN ORDINANCE OF MARTIN COUNTY, STATE OF INDIANA,
RE-ESTABLISHING
THE MARTIN COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICY

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has previously established a personnel policy for employees of Martin County by Ordinance No. 92-10, and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to make changes and revisions in said policy due to changes in law and other circumstances; and

WHEREAS, after review of prior written policies, it was deemed appropriate to revise the entire policy;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MARTIN COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1.

The revised Personnel Policy attached hereto, incorporated herein, and made a part hereof by reference is adopted as the Personnel Policy of Martin County, Indiana, for employees of Martin County.

SECTION 2.

Two (2) copies of the attached Personnel Policy shall be kept on file in the Martin County Auditor's Office for public inspection pursuant to I.C. 36-1-5-4.

SECTION 3.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the foregoing ordinance, specifically Ordinance No. 92-10, are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall not effect Sections 7, 8 and 9, of Ordinance No. 93-13, as same applies to and provides for a separate paid leave policy for full time employees of the Martin County Sheriff's Department (and Security Center), which shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4.

If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected by

such declaration and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5.

This Ordinance and Personnel Policy shall be effective upon approval and adoption according to law.
