

ORDINANCE 95-23

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MARTIN COUNTY
SUPPLEMENTAL RECORDING FEE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana, as follows:

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-2-7-10(b)(11) provides that a County Recorder may, by County Ordinance, charge a supplemental recording fee, in addition to those required by law, for services rendered by the County Recorder's Office; and

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-2-3.5-5(3) provides that the Commissioners of Martin County shall pass all ordinances for Martin County as prescribed by I.C. 36-2-4-8; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Martin County desire to establish the supplemental recording fee as provided by I.C. 36-2-7-10(b)(11).

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to I.C. 36-2-7-10 (b) (11), the Martin County Recorder shall charge a supplemental fee of \$3.00 per document, which shall be paid at the time of recording of the document.

SECTION 2. That the said supplemental recording fee of \$3.00, is in addition to all other recording fees required by law for services rendered by the County Recorder's office.

SECTION 3. That pursuant to I.C. 36-2-7-10(c) the supplemental recording fee shall be placed in the Recorder's Records Perpetuation Fund, along with the fees collected per I.C. 36-2-7-10(b)(5), I.C. 36-2-7-10(b)(6), and I.C. 36-2-7-10(b)(9), to be used by the Martin County Recorder without appropriation, for the preservation of records and the improvement of record keeping systems and equipment.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect January 1, 1996.
