

ORDINANCE NO. 98- 6

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF MARTIN COUNTY, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, IC 5-22 (the "Act") applies to every expenditure of public funds by a governmental body:

WHEREAS, Martin County (the "County") is a governmental body under the Act;

WHEREAS, the Act authorizes the County to establish a purchasing agency for the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County desires to establish a purchasing agency for the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MARTIN COUNTY, INDIANA:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby determines that it is the purchasing agency for the County.

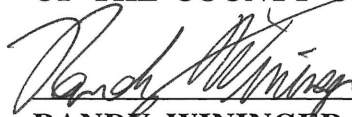
Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby designates the following persons to serve as purchasing agents for the County:

- (a) each elected County official;
- (b) each circuit, superior and County court judge;
- (c) the County highway superintendent [engineer]; and
- (d) such county employees as are designated from time to time, in writing.

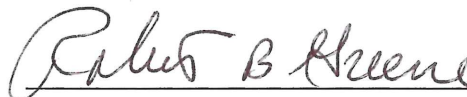
Section 3. This Ordinance is effective upon passage and signing by the presiding officer.

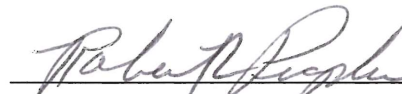

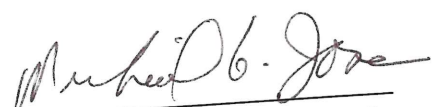
