

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-2

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONER
OF MARTIN COUNTY, INDIANA,
VACATING A PUBLIC WAY IN MARTIN COUNTY, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, Aram W. Wright, as President of: Padanaram, Inc., filed with the Board of Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana, a petition for the vacation of a part of a certain public roadway located in Mitchelltree Township in Martin County, Indiana, more particularly described as:

County Road #107, from its intersection with county road #109, being near the center of Section 33, Township 5 North, Range 3 West, and being near the center of said section, thence meandering east through Section 34, said Township and Range, to its intersection with the west line of Section 35, said Township and Range, and being approximately one and one half miles in length.

WHEREAS, notice of this petition and of the time and place of hearing thereon was published, in the manner prescribed by I.C. 5-3-1, in the Loogootee Tribune on December 23, 1999 and in the Shoals News on December 22, 1999, two newspapers of general circulation in Martin County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, all land abutting the road proposed to be vacated are now being owned by: Padanaram, Inc.

WHEREAS, at the hearing on this matter before the Board of Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana, held the 14th day of January 2000, said Board found as follows:

1. Padanaram, Inc., Aram W. Wright, is the owner of all the real property which is contiguous to that part of the roadway sought to be vacated and being a roadway as described herein above in Mitchelltree Township, Martin County, Indiana.

2. Said roadway is a public highway located entirely within Martin County, Indiana.

3. The vacation of said public highway or part thereof described as:

County Road #107, from its intersection with county road #109, being near the center of Section 33, Township 5 North, Range 3 West, and being near the center of said section, thence meandering east through Section 34, said Township and Range, to its intersection with the west line of Section 35, said Township and Range, and being approximately one and one half miles in length.

is in the best interests of the Petitioners and of Martin County, Indiana.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MARTIN COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1.

That on or after the passage of this Ordinance, that part of a roadway located in Mitchelltree Township, Martin County, Indiana, described as:

County Road #107, from its intersection with county road #109, being near the center of Section 33, Township 5 North, Range 3 West, and being near the center of said section, thence meandering east through Section 34, said Township and Range, to its intersection with the west line of Section 35, said Township and Range, and being approximately one and one half miles in length.

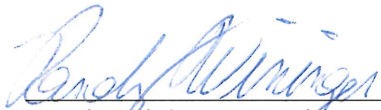
is vacated as a public highway and right of way of Martin County, Indiana.

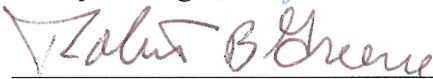
SECTION 2.

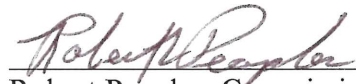
All prior ordinances passed and adopted which are in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of any such conflict.
