WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners is aware that the Southern Indiana Development Commission will be applying for housing rehabilitation grant funds from the U.S. Department of Agriculture Rural Development's Housing Preservation Grant Program for the purpose of rehabilitating housing units owned by very low income homeowners living within Martin County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners believes that the Housing Preservation Grant Program will be beneficial to Martin County.

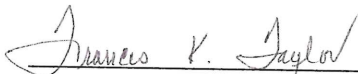
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MARTIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT:

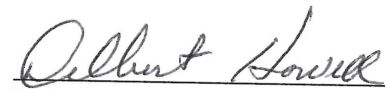

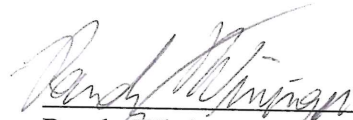
