RESOLUTION 2004- 06A

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE AUDITOR OF MARTIN COUNTY TO NOT
DISBURSE COUNTY OPTION INCOME TAX FUNDS TO THE MARTIN COUNTY
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, SEA 450 (enacted 1995) now provides that a solid waste management district may not receive a distribution to County Option Income Tax under I.C. 6-3.5-6-1 unless a majority of the members of the county fiscal body within the district pass a resolution approving the distribution; and

WHEREAS, the Martin County Solid Waste Management District has received County Option Income Tax funds since its inception Ordinance 91-10 and

WHEREAS, the Martin County Council authorized by Resolution 95-11 that the Martin County Auditor continue to distribute County Option Income Tax Funds to the Martin County Solid Waste Management District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Martin County Council doth hereby rescind Resolution 95-11 and doth authorize the Martin County Auditor to discontinue County Option Income Tax Funds to be distributed to the Martin County Solid Waste Management District.
