**WHEREAS**, the various offices and department of Martin County government have stated their desire to dispose of said items of property; and

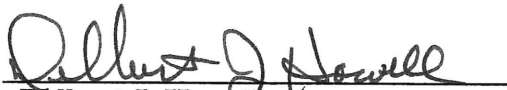
**WHEREAS**, said items of property are listed on the exhibit attached to this resolution and made a part hereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners consents to the disposal of said items of property, and

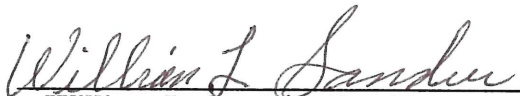

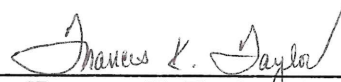
