

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-07

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE
COUNTY OF MARTIN, ESTABLISHING THE MARTIN COUNTY
REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of the County of Martin (the "Board of Commissioners"), desires to provide for the completion of local public improvements in Martin County, Indiana (the "County"); and

WHEREAS, the County, by ordinance of the Board of Commissioners, previously has created and established the Martin County Department of Redevelopment in conformance with Indiana Code 36-7-14-3, to be governed by the Martin County Redevelopment Commission; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-7-14.5 provides that a unit having a redevelopment commission may establish a redevelopment authority controlled by a board of three (3) members which may assist a redevelopment commission in undertaking such local public improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to establish a redevelopment authority;

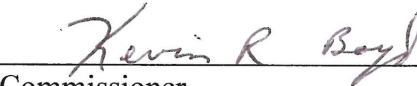
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MARTIN, AS FOLLOWS:

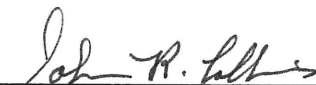
1. The Martin County Redevelopment Authority (the "Authority") is hereby created and established for the purposes and with all rights, powers, privileges and immunities now or hereafter granted to it by law, as a separate body corporate and politic and as an instrumentality of the County.

2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Board of Commissioners.

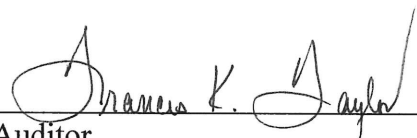
