

RESOLUTION
OF THE
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF MARTIN COUNTY, INDIANA

(A RESOLUTION DECLARING A CERTAIN STRUCTURE WITHIN THE COUNTY OF MARTIN, INDIANA A BLIGHTED SPOT FOR THE PURPOSES OF FOCUSING ATTENTION AND RESOURCES TO ADDRESS CONDITIONS WHICH HAVE CONTRIBUTED TO THE DETERIORATION OF THE STRUCTURE AND TO ENCOURAGE GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE STRUCTURE.)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana, desire to eliminate slum and blighted structures within the County boundaries of Martin County, Indiana, and

WHEREAS, identifying such a structure is necessary for effective action to eliminate slum and blighting conditions; and

WHEREAS, public improvements such as sidewalks and streets have severely deteriorated, contributing to slum and blighting conditions, and

WHEREAS, the structure has experienced a cessation of private investment since 2002, and

WHEREAS, the structure is listed on the State and National Registers in Indiana, and

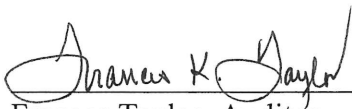
WHEREAS, widespread deterioration of the structure has taken place as evidenced by crumbling facades, broken or boarded windows, falling ceilings, lacking of original features, and

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana that the following property of Martin County, Indiana hereby be designated as blighted as defined by Indiana Code 36-7-14.

A part of Lot Numbered Seventy-One (71) in the Original Plat of West Shoals, Indiana, more particularly described as follows: (see attached warranty deed)

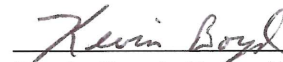
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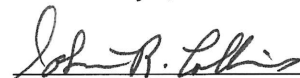
