

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-04

**RESOLUTION OF THE MARTIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
REGARDING HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS**

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners have determined to provide group health insurance benefits for those county employees that choose to participate in the program; and

WHEREAS, said health insurance benefits program provides for Martin County government to contribute the sum of \$1,500.00 HSA contribution for a single employee and \$3,500.00 HSA contribution for employee and family to be utilized for payment toward health care expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desire to provide for the orderly payment of HSA benefits to employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Martin County Board of Commissioners as follows:

1. That the Auditor of Martin County shall pay HSA benefits to employees on a monthly basis by dividing the total amount of payment due to employee by twenty-six (26) pays and including said amount in the paycheck of participating employees; and
2. That the Martin County Auditor shall adjust payment of HSA benefit payments to employees as necessary upon being provided written justification that payment in a manner other than over twenty-six (26) paychecks is necessary; and
3. That in the event of the termination of employment of any Martin County employee that is participating in the health insurance benefit program, the Martin County Auditor shall compute said employee's per diem share of the HSA benefit payment and shall pay said amount through the employee's last day of work.

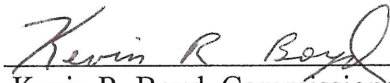

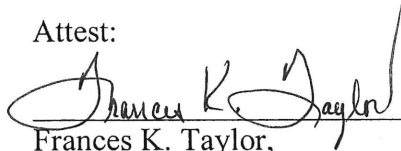
