Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana:

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners has statutory authority to employ personnel to perform work on behalf of Martin County and to establish the terms of employment; and

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners has previously established that a full-time employee must work no less than thirty-seven and one-half (37 ½) hours per work week in order to be classified as a full-time employee eligible for employment benefits; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana, that an employee who has successfully completed the Introductory Period of employment and who works at least thirty-six (36) hours per week is considered as a full-time employee eligible for employment benefits, and

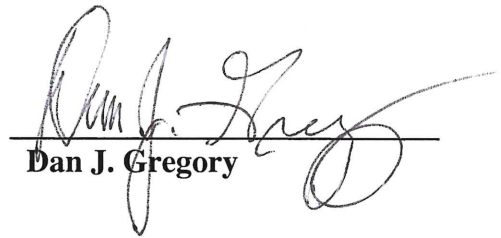
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said change shall be effective beginning with the pay period beginning May ¹³16, 2009.

Adopted this 12 day of May, 2009.

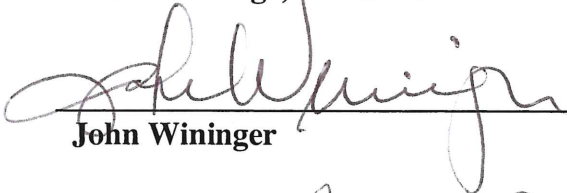

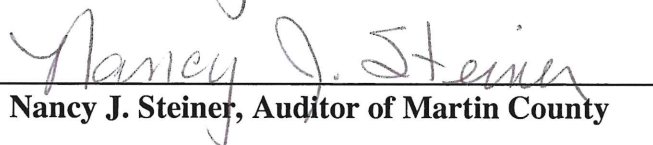
