A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER REMAINING BALANCES OF THE FAMILY AND CHILDREN'S FUND AND THE CHILDREN'S PSYCHIATRIC RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT SERVICES FUND FROM THE LEVY EXCESS FUND TO THE COUNTY RAINY DAY FUND.

WHEREAS, Public Law 146-2008 repealed the County Family and Children's Fund (IC 12-19-7 before its repeal); and the County Children's Psychiatric Residential Treatment Services Fund (IC 12-19-7.5 before its repeal); and

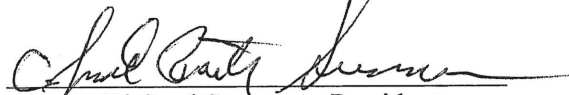
WHEREAS, Indiana Code 6-1.1-18.5-17 mandated the County transfer any excess balances from the County Family and Children's Fund and the County Children's Psychiatric Residential Treatment Services Fund to the County Levy Excess Fund; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 182-2009 allows Counties to transfer said balances from the County Levy Excess Fund to the County Rainy Day Fund;

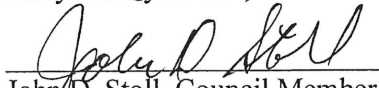
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF MARTIN COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The remaining balance of the County Family and Children's Fund now in the Levy Excess Fund in the amount of \$50,957.21 is hereby transferred to the County Rainy Day Fund.
2. There is no balance to transfer in the County Children's Psychiatric Residential Treatment Services Fund.

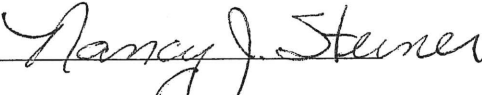
IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the County Council of Martin County, Indiana, determine that this Resolution be deemed effective this 3rd day of August, 2009.

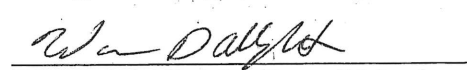

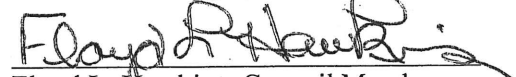

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Family and Children + Children's Psychiatric Residential Treatment Funds

Dear Council Members and County Auditors,

As many of you probably know the recently passed state budget contains provisions allowing County Councils to pass a resolution transferring excess balances from the repealed family and children's fund and the county children's psychiatric residential treatment services fund to the county rainy day fund.

This must be done before Dec. 31, 2009.

Levy Excess Welfare to 50,957.21 Balance to Rainy Day

If a county has an aggregate amount in the two funds over \$10,000,000 then the distribution to the rainy day fund includes the other taxing units in the county. This should only apply to Lake and St. Joseph Counties.
